- Need for access to standardised somatic reporting templates
 - Pick up through work of S-VIG
- Need for collaborative infrastructure for variant discussion/interpretation
 - Pick up through work of CanVIG-UK
- Need to develop gene specific variant interpretation guidelines
 - Pick up through work of CanVIG-UK

Areas for future work

- Webinar in near future to develop more in depth donor testing and consent and counselling pathways
- Develop gene specific guidelines outside of the context of this meeting
- Use this data to lobby for resources for national registry to allow the community to collect data in a standardised way according to clear SOPs
- Work to get standardised patient information with patient groups
